Jarrett Keohokalole, Primary Challenger to Rep. Ed Case, Raises \$220,000 in FEC Q3

(HONOLULU, HI) State Senator Jarrett Keohokalole's campaign for Congress today announced it has raised over \$220,000 by the latest Federal Election Commission (FEC) filing deadline. The total reflects a growing coalition of community members, business leaders, and labor organizations across the First Congressional district united behind Keohokalole's message of new leadership.

"This milestone is a testament to the energy, urgency, and action our campaign is built around," said Jarrett Keohokalole. "I'm out knocking on doors every week and people from every corner of the district are coming together because they are hungry for change. They want lower costs for families, accountability in government, and a voice in Congress that delivers for our island home. I am grateful for this outpouring of support and more committed than ever to fight for working people."

Keohokalole announced his candidacy for Congress on July 29, 2025, the same day Hawai'i residents spent most of the day under a Tsunami warning. He has since garnered a wave of early endorsements, including those from the International Longshore and Warehouse Union (ILWU) Local 142, the Hawaii Regional Council of Carpenters Local 745, the United Food and Commercial Workers Union Local 480, the Hawaii Laborers' Union Local 368, and others. He has outpaced expectations, signaling that voters are ready for new leaders in Washington, D.C.

"It's exciting to see how far we've come in just a couple of months. Our volunteers are seeing real enthusiasm from voters who want results, and Jarrett's record of leadership in the Legislature is resonating across the district," said Campaign Manager Tyler Gomes.

Honorary Co-Chair Erika Moritsugu, a leading national AAPI advocate, highlighted the broader significance. "Hawai'i's next member of Congress will shape national policy and serve as a critical voice



for the AAPI community and working families everywhere. The strong and diverse support for Jarrett shows that our communities are ready for a leader who stands up, takes action, and delivers results."

With this momentum, the campaign is expanding its grassroots organizing efforts, ramping up outreach, and preparing to take its message to even more voters across the district.
